A "Rap Up" is a unique hip-hop comedy experience, a custom rap written for your event, at your event. The concept was devised by Canadian hip-hop artist Baba Brinkman, an award winning playwright and freestyle rapper who has turned his craft towards such diverse subjects as evolution and literature.

HOW A RAP UP WORKS

Baba sits in on an event, whether a conference, meeting, lecture, performance, fundraiser, award show, or anything at all, taking notes and writing down the key phrases, ideas, and impressions, while composing an original rap/poem on the fly in real time. Then, as the final act of the event, he steps to the stage and performs the rap, interpreting and commenting on the proceedings in his signature tongue-in-cheek style.

ABOUT BABA BRINKMAN

The world's first and only "peer-reviewed" rapper, Baba Brinkman is best known for his hip-hop plays "The Rap Guide to Evolution" and "The Canterbury Tales Remixed" which adapt the works of Charles Darwin and Geoffrey Chaucer for a modern audience (both performances can be excerpted and combined with a Rap Up). Baba's unique blend of social commentary and hip-hop wit is part Eminem and part Louis CK, a sure-fire way to make your gathering memorable.
